## Community Paramedicine

- Project DAWN.** Became the first Wood County fire/EMS department to participate in the Leave it Behind naloxone program.
- Community AED Program.** Obtained a quote for our new AED to pursue alternative funding.
- April 6:** Attended Safe Kids of Greater Toledo Meeting, opening the door to future training and outreach including car seat inspections, fire prevention, and a bike helmet project.
- April 17:** Discussed CRR's potential to lower insurance premiums with the State Fire Marshal's Office.
  - Coordinator Rosebrock is currently enrolled in a Life, Fire Safety Educator Level 1 class at Ohio Fire Academy (OFA) in July which will improve our ISO rating.
  - Coordinator Rosebrock is enrolled in a Youth Fire Setter Course at OFA in November.

  - Began the process to join the CARES Program, which tracks cardiac arrests to improve survival rates.
