#### Community Paramedicine

- **Project DAWN.** Became the first Wood County fire/EMS department to participate in the Leave it Behind naloxone program.
- Community AED Program. Obtained a quote for our new AED to pursue alternative funding.
- **April 6:** Attended Safe Kids of Greater Toledo Meeting, opening the door to future training and outreach including car seat inspections, fire prevention, and a bike helmet project.
- April 17: Discussed CRR's potential to lower insurance premiums with the State Fire Marshal's Office.
  - Coordinator Rosebrock is currently enrolled in a Life, Fire Safety Educator Level 1 class at Ohio Fire Academy (OFA) in July which will improve our ISO rating.
  - o Coordinator Rosebrock is enrolled in a Youth Fire Setter Course at OFA in November.
- April 18: Coordinator Rosebrock and EMT Shaner completed the Car Fit Technician Course. This course is to help educate the elderly population in safe driving techniques
- April 26: Attended the Children's Health and Wellness Symposium, which led to a discussion with the community impact director for the American Heart Association.
  - Connection with Lake School athletic trainer for future training and coordination
  - Began the process to join the CARES Program, which tracks cardiac arrests to improve survival rates.
- Stop the Bleed. Scheduled an instructor Class for May 12th to be able to offer community classes.
